Financial Leverage Ratio

For the period 30 September 2023

The Group's financial leverage ratio comprises of Tier (1) capital (As defined in the instructions on capital of Islamic banks Standard) divided by total exposures which consists of:

1. On-balance sheet exposures
2. Exposures of hedging contracts compliant with Islamic Sharia'a Standards.
3. off-balance sheet exposures

At 30 September 2023, the financial leverage ratio is 9.98% (30 September 2022: 7.72%) compared to the ratio required by regulatory authorities of 3%, Tier (1) Capital of KD 395,370 thousand (30 September 2022: KD 324,036 thousand) and total exposures is KD 3,960,262 thousand (30 September 2022: KD 4,196,480 thousand).
